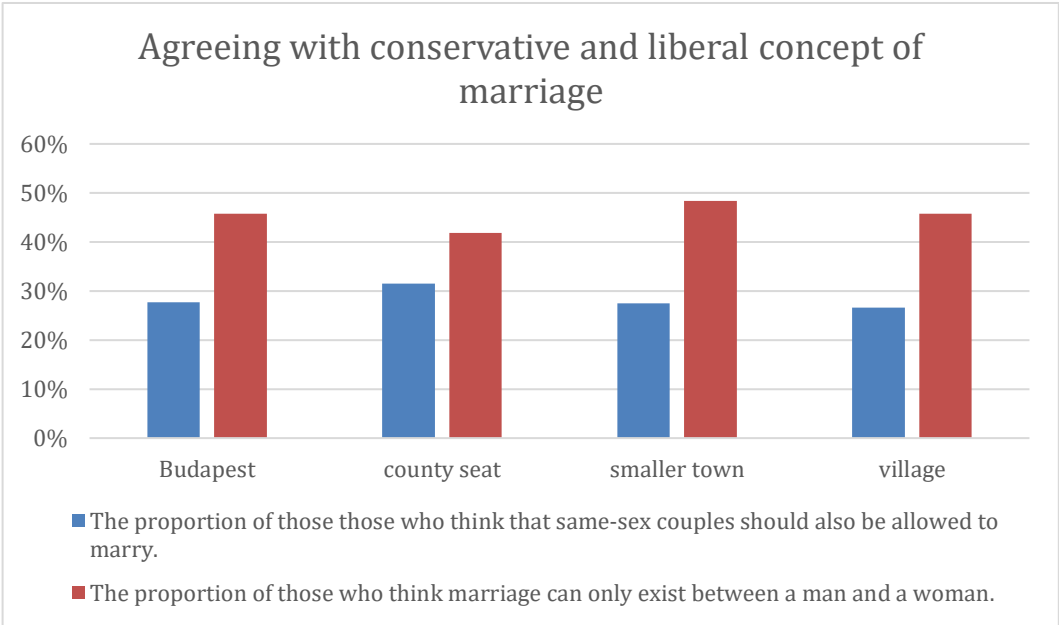
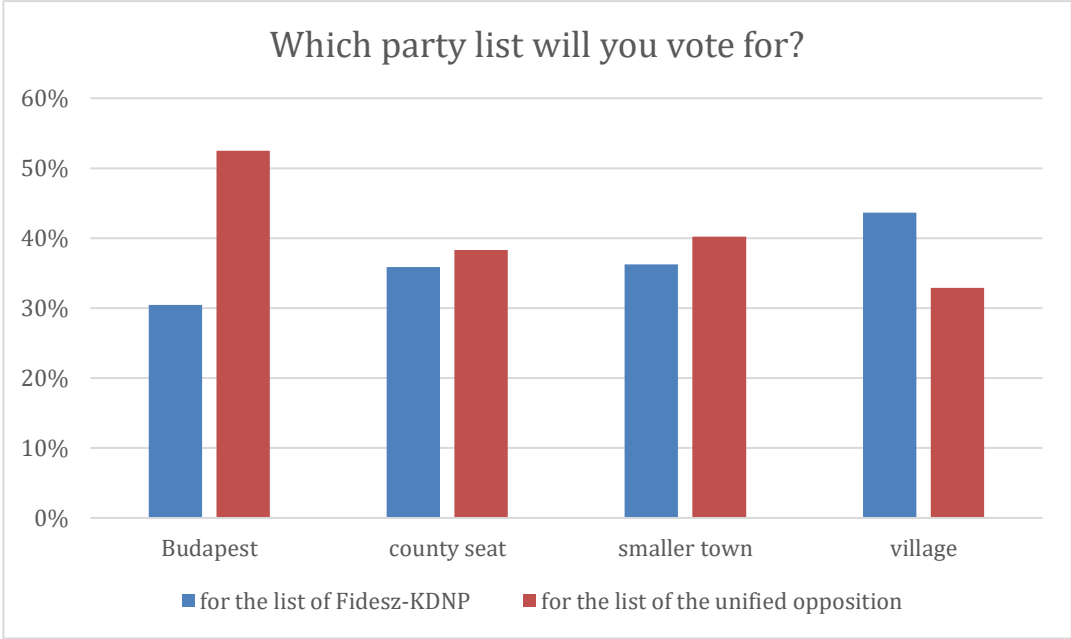
## SUMMARY

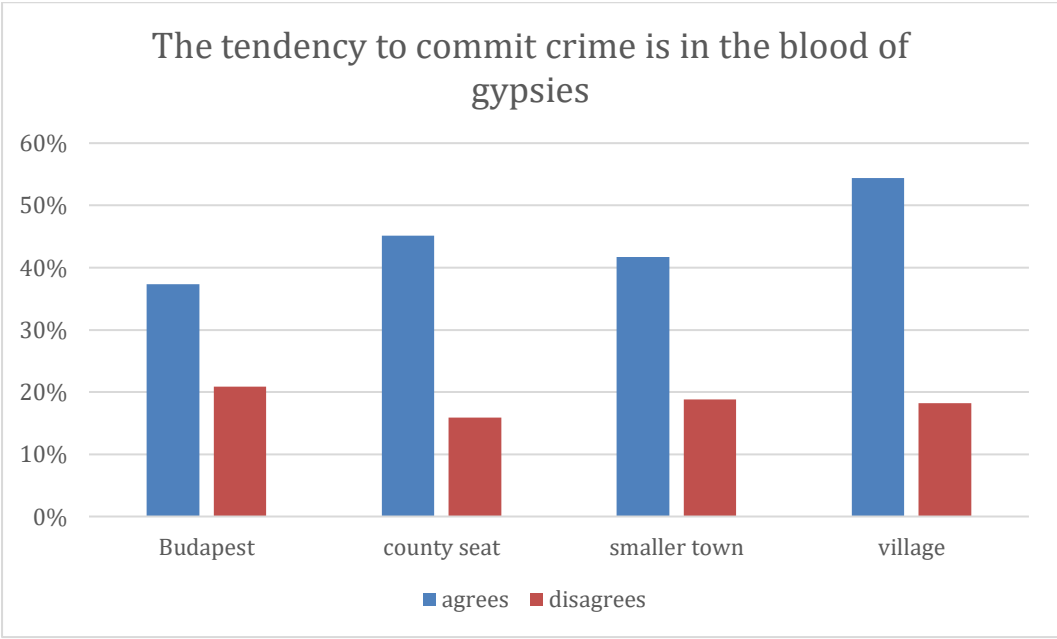
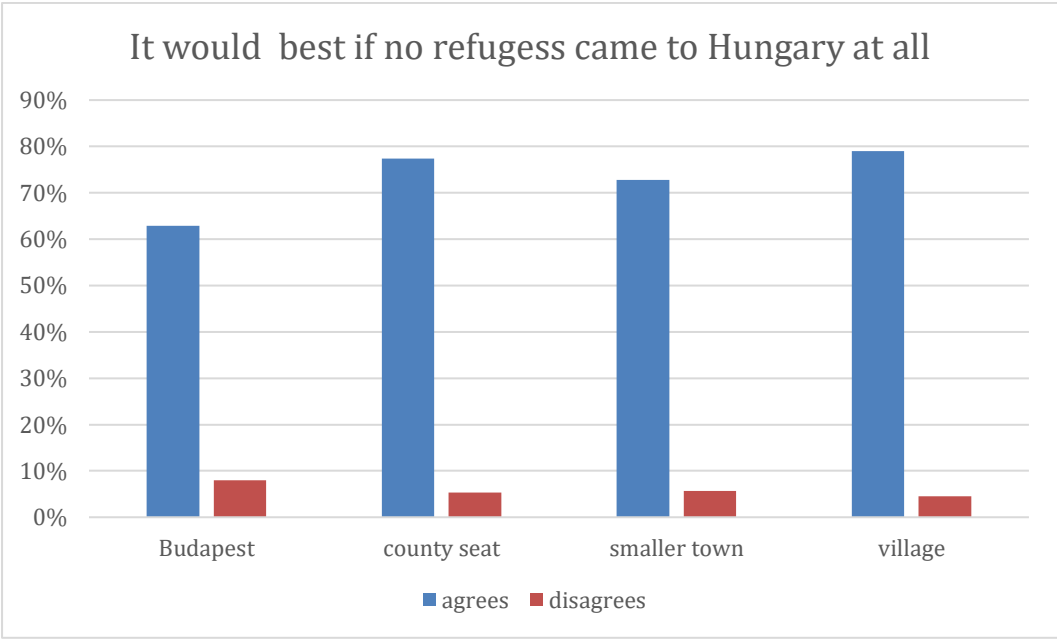
- In Hungary the majority of the population -regardless of the type of settlement- believes that things are going in the wrong direction in the country.
- As far as their personal life situation is concerned, respondents are even more dissatisfied: in none of the settlement types did the proportion of those who consider themselves to be among the winners of the governance of the previous years reach 15 percent.
- The proportion of respondents who would be happier if the Fidesz government was replaced in the next election is higher everywhere in the country apart from the villages.
- Against the single common opposition list the governing parties could only win in the villages.
- Most residents of Budapest consider themselves to be liberal while in rural settlements the majority of residents consider themselves to have a strong national feeling.
- Hungarians are strongly pro-EU and more pro-Western, regardless of their place of residence.
- For the time being, in contrast to the residents of the capital and county seats, in smaller towns and villages the majority still consists of residents who are satisfied with the state of democracy, but the difference between the two camps is very narrow.
- In every settlement type, high living costs and low salaries were named as the gravest problems of the country, followed by the poor quality of the healthcare.
- Regardless of the general worldview, from the economic perspective the majority of country's population in every settlement type favours left-wing, egalitarian views.
- In terms of media consumption, a considerable difference between the residents of the various settlement types is present in the rate of reading online news and watching the national television.



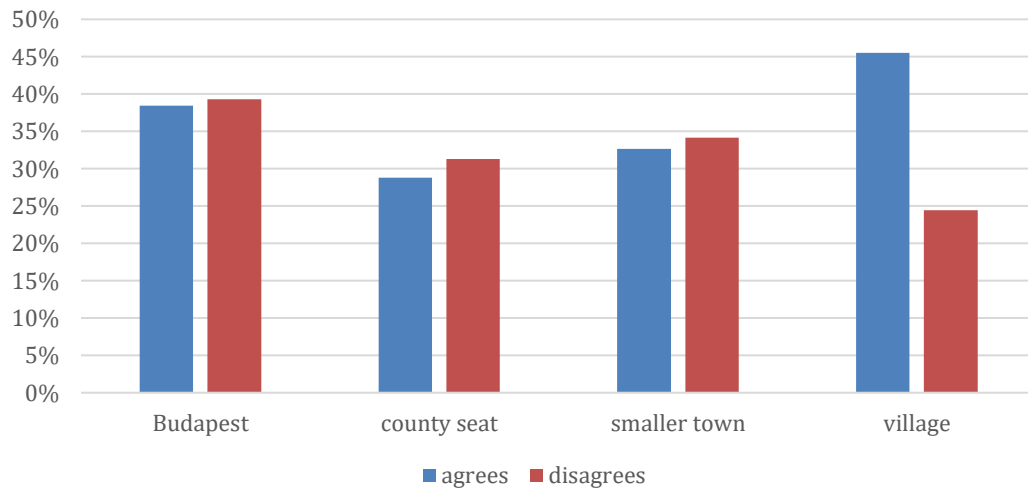




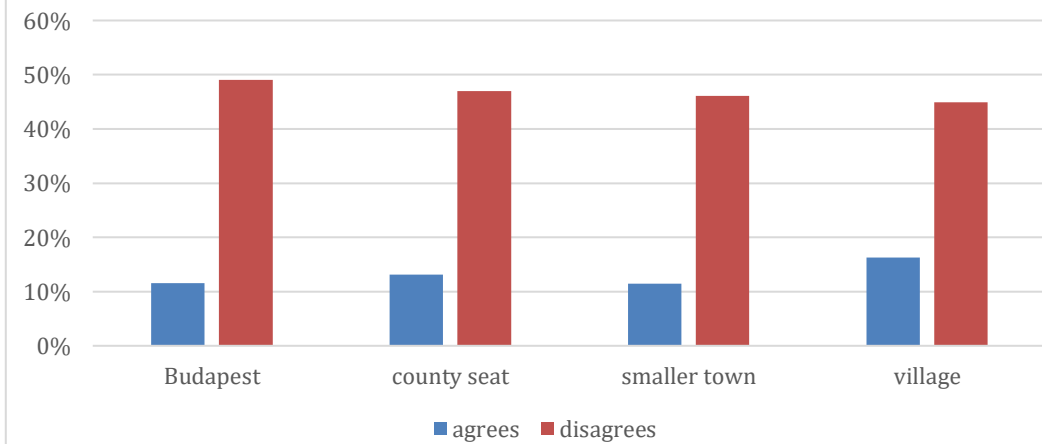




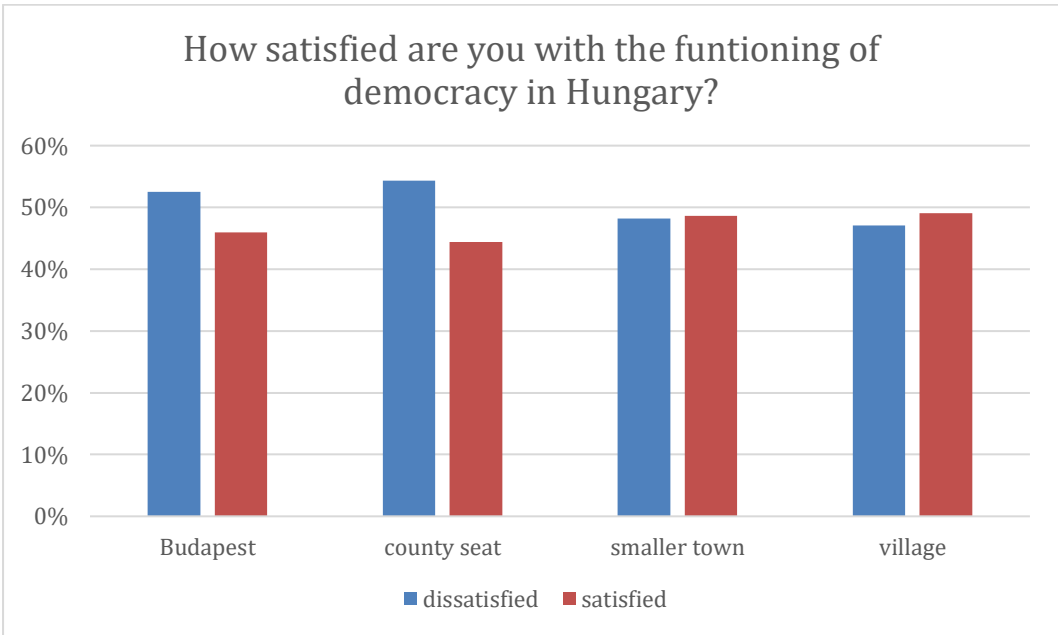
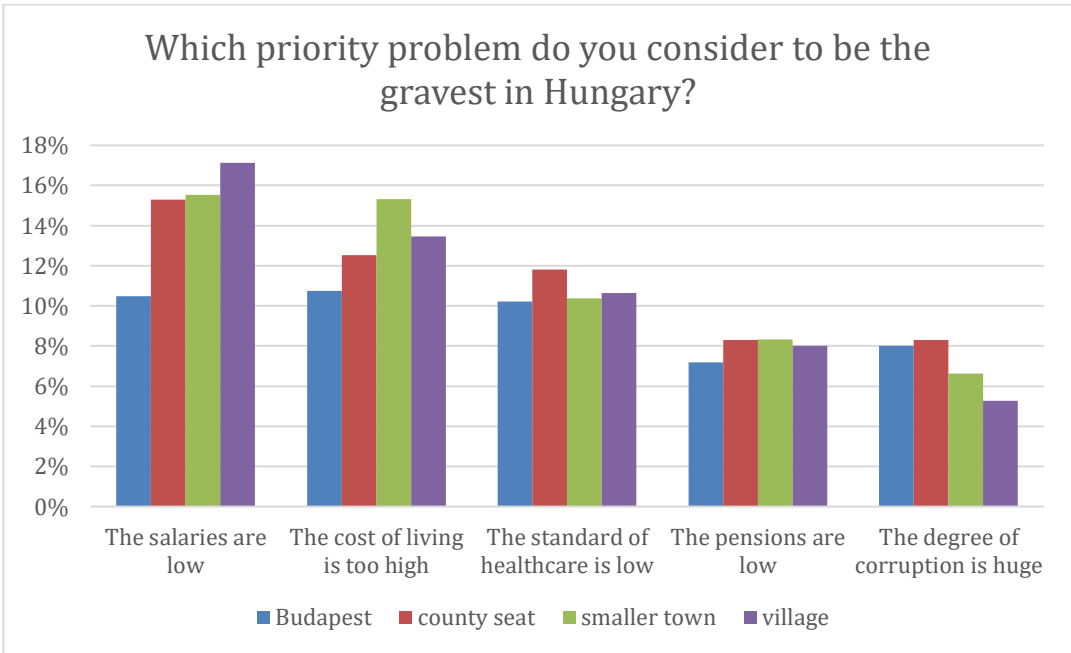
