SUMMARY

- In the member states of the European Union, 69-85% of the responding LGBTI people became clear about their identity before the age of 18.
- Thus, LGBTI youth is present in schools, their identity is formed earlier, it is not “brought in” by lobby organisations.
- Even though the LGBTI identity is formed before the age of 18, in most cases of the people concerned they only talk about it as adults.
- In Hungary, 44% of the LGBTI people were laughed at, bullied, insulted, and threatened during their school years.
- Thus, if it is not possible to talk about homosexuality in schools, then the LGBTI minors will continue to be exposed to verbal and physical abuse.
- While on average 68% of the respondents in the EU believe that their government does not react adequately to the security needs of the LGBTI people, in Hungary, this rate is 95%.

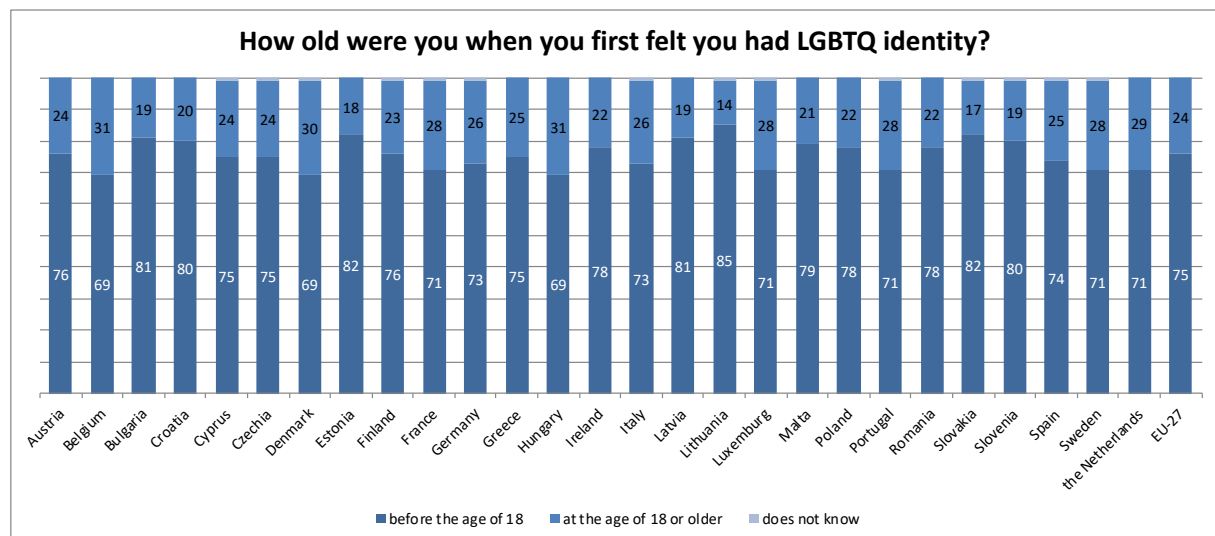


Figure 1.: the formation of LGBTI identity and age, source: FRA

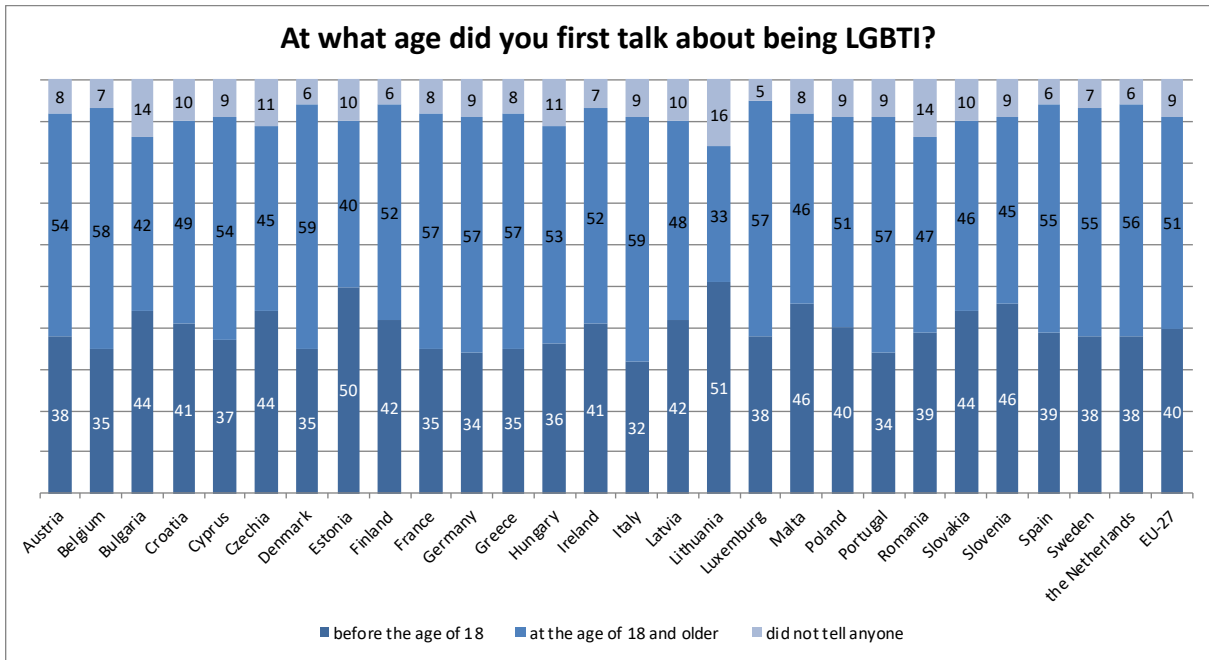


Figure 2.: Discussion about identity and age, source: FRA

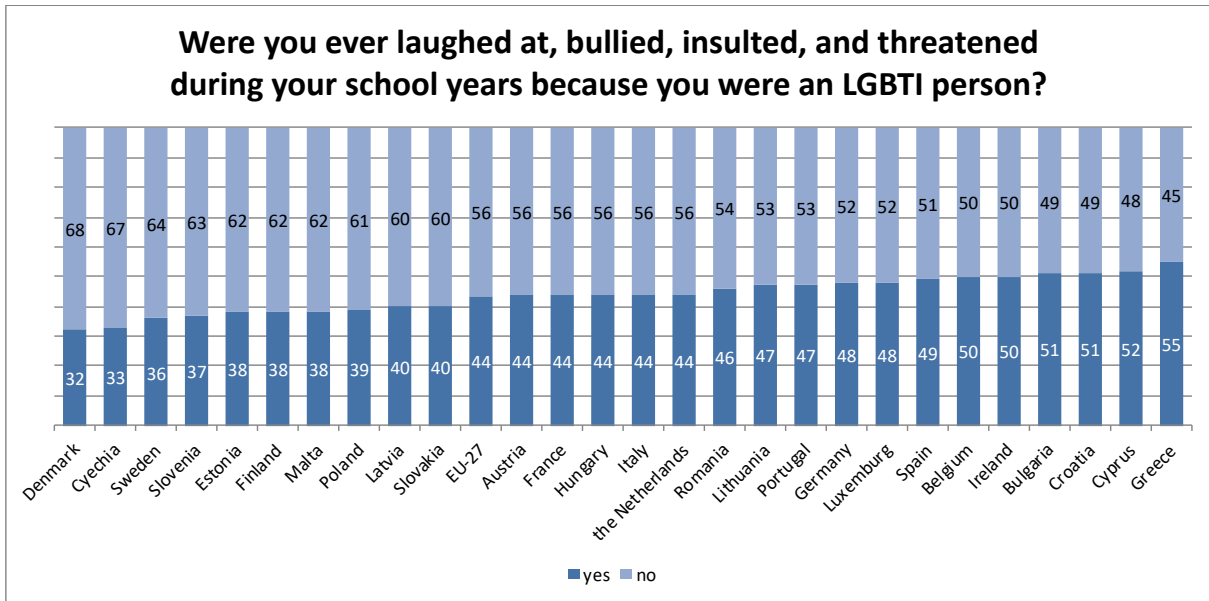


Figure 3.: School abuse, source: FRA

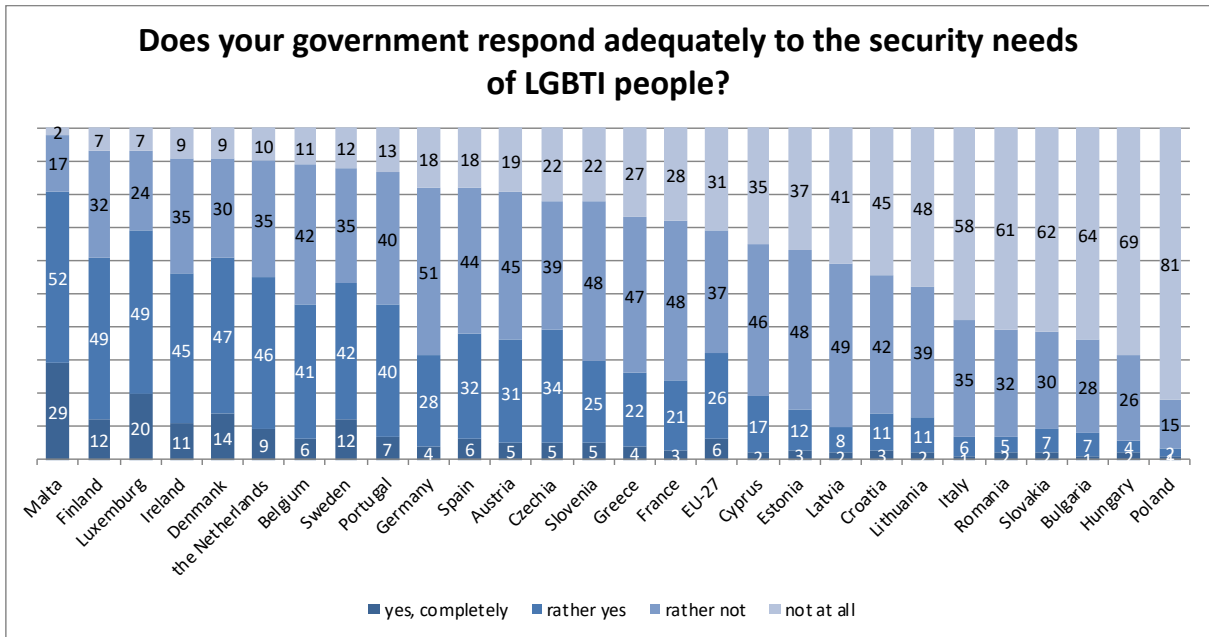


Figure 4.: Governmental protection of LGBTI people, source: FRA
